Two exemplary pictures of aged FUdR-treated N2 and auxin-fed PX627 to show the visible effect of FUdR and auxin on aged nematodes. While the use of FUdR

causes a developmental arrest resulting in an inability to lay eggs (Supplementary Figure 1A), auxin leads to the development of unfertilized eggs which can be situated normally (Supplementary Figure 1B).
